- When collecting survey data among pupils, ask them to rate observable teacher behaviours.
- When interviewing teachers on video, ask them to describe their interaction with pupils and to explain how it relates to pupils' learning outcomes.
- When interviewing pupils on video, ask them to describe which teacher actions helped or hindered their learning and why.
- Produce an action video of the lessons under evaluation and show it to the teacher and pupils.
- Discuss the findings from surveys and interviews with the teacher and pupils and record their reactions on video.
- Report and utilise conclusions and recommendations for curriculum development.
